If you're unsure how many trips you will take during the year, the Single Trip option is recommended. If you anticipate taking three or more trips during the year, the Annual option provides the best value.

2 Individual or Family*
An individual plan covers just you. A family* plan provides coverage for you, your spouse or domestic partner, and up to four of your children.

3 Travel Solve or Travel Solve Plus
The Travel Solve plan includes Medical Transportation and Mortal Remains Transportation services, along with 24/7 Travel Assistance Services. If you would like to add Security Evacuation and Involuntary Detention services, select the Travel Solve Plus plan.
